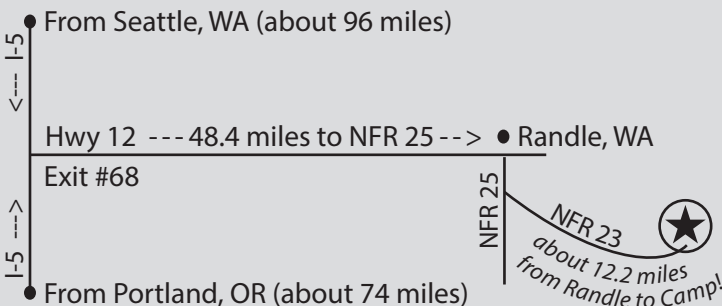

Directions from I-5:

- Take Exit #68, Hwy 12, East to Randle, WA. (48.4 miles)
- At mile marker 115, turn onto National Forest Road (NFR) 25, aka County Rd 9009/WA-131 (1 mile)
- Go left at "Y" onto NFR 23, aka Cispus Rd (10.8 miles) Note that at 7-8 miles into this, NFR 23 and Cispus Rd split. Continue on NFR 23 at the split.
- ⚙️ Slight left in to Camp! (0.4 miles)
